Thank you for your interest in enrolling your child at NACA. Please read through all of the guidelines thoroughly before completing the application. We are currently accepting applications for sixth (6th) grade through eleventh (11th) grade.

Please complete the attached **2014-15** school year application and return it to the school via drop off or by mailing it to 4499 Loch Raven Boulevard, Baltimore, MD 21218.

Parent(s) and child must be residents of Baltimore City. Proof of residency will be required for enrollment.

An application must be submitted for the current school year you are applying for. Applications must be submitted by *February 21, 2014* to be considered for the enrollment lottery.

If NACA receives more applications by the designated cut-off date than we have slots available, per grade, those applications will go into an enrollment lottery. Children of NACA founders and siblings of prior enrolled students will be given first preference.

The lottery will be held on *February 28, 2014*. The available slots will be offered in the order they are drawn.

You will be notified <u>by mail</u> of your child's application status by March 3, 2014. No further updates will be available regarding admissions until this time.

If your child is not selected for placement during the enrollment lottery, your child's name will be placed on a waiting list and you may be contacted as space becomes available.
